**T**HE NEW ENGLAND TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY endeavors to provide:

*A capacity for effective service, by the installation and maintenance of a well-constructed plant, with such provision for future extensions as prudent foresight directs.*

*A capacity for efficient service by the trained ability of over 14,000 employees.*

It serves the four northern New England States, which, although a closely allied community, are developed on a wide variety of manufacturing, mercantile and agricultural interests, and a diversity of social requirements. Comprehensive telephone service is determined by a variety of factors, therefore, and by a regard for the requirements of the community as a whole, rather than of any detached part.

On January 1, 1917, this Company had attached to its system, in the four northern New England States, 622,000 telephones, an average of approximately one telephone to each ten inhabitants. There is hardly a community in its territory which cannot be reached by telephone over its lines or over the lines of its connecting companies. Its association with the American Telephone & Telegraph Company enables it to give this community long-distance service to any part of the United States or Canada, within the range of telephone transmission.

## CORRECT USE OF TELEPHONE

### EMERGENCY CALLS.

In cases of emergency the Company desires to render such aid as possible by furnishing emergency local exchange service without charge. In order to facilitate this service, calls should be made as follows:

Say to the Operator, "Fire Department—Emergency," "Police Department—Emergency," or "Give me a doctor—Emergency," as the case requires. If possible, wait at the telephone until you can give your message direct; if you cannot wait, tell the Operator the nature of the emergency, the exact location where help is needed and the number of the telephone which you are using. If you require a specified doctor, make the call by name or number, and say "Emergency."

In case of explosions, wrecks, broken gas or water mains, or any emergency affecting public safety, tell the Operator that the call is an emergency one, and she will aid in every way possible.

Such emergency calls may be made without charge as a free public service, and the Company cannot assume any responsibility therefor.

### LOCAL CALLS.

**Method of Calling.** Obtain from the latest Directory the number of the party desired and call the Operator in the usual way. When the Operator responds with "Number, please," give her your order slowly and distinctly. First name the exchange desired and then pronounce the number by digits. For example: "Portsmouth 416-2" should be pronounced "Portsmouth four-one-six ring two." "Portsmouth 446-M" should be pronounced "Portsmouth four-four-six M." "Portsmouth 2000" should be pronounced "Portsmouth Two Thousand." "Portsmouth 2300" should be pronounced "Portsmouth two-three-hundred." When the Operator repeats the number, be sure she has received the order correctly.

**Answering Calls.** In answering calls, time will be saved if you state your own number or name instead of saying "Hello." Do not remove the receiver from the hook while the bell is ringing, as this may cause other subscribers on the line to be called in error.

**Busy Lines.** When the line which you call is reported busy, or when you get a busy signal, hang up the receiver and call again after a few minutes. It is easier for the Operator to complete a call than to report the line busy, and therefore it is fair to assume that she is stating the correct

facts. If your message is urgent, ask for the Supervisor and request her to take such action as advisable.

**Recalling the Operator.** If you wish to recall the Operator during a connection, move the hook slowly up and down five or six times, or until the Operator answers. Do not move the hook rapidly, as this does not operate the signal. If your telephone is equipped with a bell crank, give one short ring.

**Holding the Line.** When you are holding the line, do not replace the receiver on the hook, as this may give the Operator a signal to disconnect the line.

### "NUMBER ONLY" TOLL CALLS.

All calls, the rate for which is 10 cents or less, are "Number Only" calls. Obtain from the latest Telephone Directory the exchange and number of the party desired. Call the local Operator in the usual way, give her the exchange and number and wait at the telephone until the connection is completed or until report is made to you.

### "PARTICULAR PARTY" TOLL CALLS.

All calls the rate for which is 20 cents or over, are "Particular Party" calls. Call the local operator in the usual way and ask for "Toll Operator to . . . . . (name of place). When the Toll Operator answers, give her the name of your exchange, your telephone number, and your own name and the name of the exchange desired, the telephone number, if known, and the name of the particular party with whom you wish to speak. After you have given the Operator the necessary information, she will say, "The Operator will call you," then replace the receiver on the hook until you are called.

**Notification of Toll Charge.** If you wish to know the amount of the toll charge for your message, it can be given with minimum delay if you will advise the Toll Operator of your desire when you give the details of your call.

**Messenger Service.** If you wish to call a party other than a telephone subscriber, it may be possible for a Public Telephone Agent to send a messenger to request the desired party to come to a public telephone. The Public Telephone Agent will make a charge for the messenger service whether the desired party responds or not, but toll charge will be made only if conversation takes place. The Company cannot guarantee that the Public Telephone Agent will be able to furnish a messenger.

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

**Exchange Service.** A subscriber to exchange service is entitled, without payment of toll charges, to service with subscribers' stations connected with the exchange or exchanges covered by the contract for the class of service subscribed for. Contracts are written for one year.

**Measured Service.** Measured service is exchange service furnished on the basis of established rates for messages within the exchange service area specified in the subscriber's contract.

Each message shall be limited to five minutes from the time of answer at the station called. Each additional five-minute period or fraction thereof shall be charged as an additional message.

Service charges from the date of installation to the date of acceptance of contract shall be on pro rata basis with an additional charge in the case of private branch exchange service for excess messages used.

Excess messages shall be billed monthly as used.

If the messages used in any month are less than the proportional annual guarantee, the difference shall be credited if there is a charge for excess messages during the same guarantee year, but credits shall not exceed the charge for such excess messages.

If an annual contract is terminated after its primary term, service charges shall be on pro rata basis, plus charge for messages used in excess of the proportional annual guarantee.

**Temporary Suspension of Service.** The Company will temporarily suspend exchange service under established practices, upon request by the subscriber.

**Mileage.** The regularly established exchange service rates cover exchange service furnished subscribers within a defined area. Mileage at established rates is added when subscribers are located outside such area.

**Special Construction.** When special construction is necessary in order to establish service, a charge therefor will be made to the subscriber.

**Use of Instruments and Apparatus.** The instruments and apparatus furnished to the subscriber shall be carefully used in accordance with the rules of the Company; shall not be removed from the subscriber's premises nor connected with any instrument or apparatus not furnished by the Company; shall be used by the subscriber, his agents or employees only when engaged in his business and shall not be used in any way in competition with the business conducted by the Company.

**Residence Service.** Residence service contracts of the Company permit the use of the telephone for usual social and domestic purposes, but do not permit habitual use for business purposes, and any habitual use of residence service for business purposes will constitute a violation of the residence service contract.

**Failure of Service.** For any complete failure of exchange service continued more than twenty-four hours and brought to the notice of the Company in writing within ten days, the Company will make a pro rata abatement of charge or guarantee; but in view of the liability to errors in transmitting speech by telephone and the impossibility of fairly fixing the cause thereof, all other risks of service are assumed by the subscriber.

**Changes in Location or Style of Station Equipment.** The Company will change the location or style of station equipment upon request by the subscriber who has the option of paying the regular charge therefor, or of terminating his

contract (see "Termination of Contracts") and then renewing such contract for a new primary term under established practices.

**Changes in Class of Service.** The Company will change the class of a subscriber's service upon written request. Adjustment of charges for the service terminated will be made on pro rata basis without extra charge and without extending the primary term of the contract, except that if the change is made from private branch exchange service during the primary term of the contract, the private branch exchange contract shall be terminated in accordance with the Company's short term rates, and if the change is made to private branch exchange service, a new contract under established practices shall be required.

**Transfer of Contracts.** Subscribers may arrange for the transfer of their contracts to other parties at the same location provided only that there is complete continuity of billing. The station designation will not be transferred to the new party without the written assent of the subscriber whose contract is transferred. A contract covering auxiliary service is automatically transferred when the main contract is transferred.

**Termination of Contracts.** Subscribers may terminate their contracts during the primary term upon payment of established short term rates for the service furnished. A contract for auxiliary service is automatically terminated (on short term basis if during the primary term or on pro rata basis thereafter) when the main contract is terminated.

**Interruption of Service for Nonpayment.** If the subscriber defaults payment or otherwise violates the terms of this contract or of these terms and conditions, the Company may interrupt the service or remove the station or stations.

**Reestablishment of Service.** The Company's established charges will be made for reestablishing service which has been interrupted or removed for nonpayment.

**Statement of Accounts.** If no objection in writing is received by the Company within ten days after statement of account is rendered, such statement shall be deemed to be correct.

**Directory.** The Company will not be responsible for errors in its directory or for any failure to comply with requests for listings. The directory numbers of the subscriber's station or stations may be changed by the Company at any time as the exigencies of its business may require.

The numbers of party line subscribers are especially subject to change.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

**Commercial Offices** are located at the headquarters of the various Managers. All Commercial matters relating to Contracts, Collections and Adjustments in these exchanges will be given prompt attention by calling for the Manager. Such local calls may be made without charge.

**Payment of Bills.** Service contracts, signed by the subscriber and accepted by the Company, agree that all bills become due on presentation. Bills are rendered in arrears and include charges for services already rendered, and the Company feels justified in requesting a careful observation

# Don't "Jiggle" The Hook

When you take the receiver off the switchhook of your telephone, a small electric lamp is lighted on the switchboard in front of the operator. To that signal she responds with the familiar "Number, please?"

After your connection has been made with the other person, the lights go out and do not reappear until the receivers are placed on the switchhooks again; which signals then indicate to the operator that the conversation has ended.

If you desire to get the operator's attention, you may do so by moving the receiver hook down and up, but **IT MUST BE DONE SLOWLY**, or the little lamp will not have time to glow and the operator will not get any signal. Your observance of this method of signaling will insure more prompt attention by the operator and will help to make the service better.
